


Rama & Ramara

Experience our First Nation history

RAMA & RAMARA (100km/1.5 Hours)~

Begin your journey on Rama Road and enjoy the breath taking fall colours, watch for the Osprey nests. Only minutes into your drive you will pass Casino Rama Resort, home to restaurants, shopping, an entertainment venue, casino and hotel. Continue through the passage filled with autumn shades into Washago. e Where you wil find R Cottage restaurant a treat for all travellers. Follow the route to highway 169 and continue until Monck Road. These next few kilometers are a wonderful drive through a forest full of fall colours. Return to Highway 169, into Brechin. Visit Lagoon City, a charming place to explore and is home to the Lakeview Restaurant. Your journey will continue to McRae Provincial Parks (Closing October 10th), great places to walk and enjoy the scenic beauty of water and fall colours. The final stop of this incredible route is at the Ramara Trail, stroll through the trees and discover the historical Mnjikaning Fish Weirs, found at the narrows where Lake Simcoe and Lake Couchiching meet. Follow highway 12 back into Orillia.



Mnjikaning Fish Weirs was designated a national historic site of Canada in 1982 because the site contains the largest and best preserved fish weirs known in eastern North America. This is a sacred place that represents an ancient and ongoing spiritual bond between the Creator and all living things.

THINGS TO DO ALONG THE WAY:

HIKE:

Walk along the Ramara Trail through a canopy of fall colours. At the end of the trail you can look out onto the Mnjikaning Fish Weirs.

EXPLORE:

Get in touch with nature, explore McRae Provincial Parks and paddle the shores of Lake Simcoe.

DISCOVER:

Learn about our First Nation heritage at Rama First Nations or visit Rama Moccasin and Smoke.

EAT:

Enjoy a dining experience at any one of our restaurants along this route including Casino Rama Resort, R Cottage or Lakeview Restaurant.
